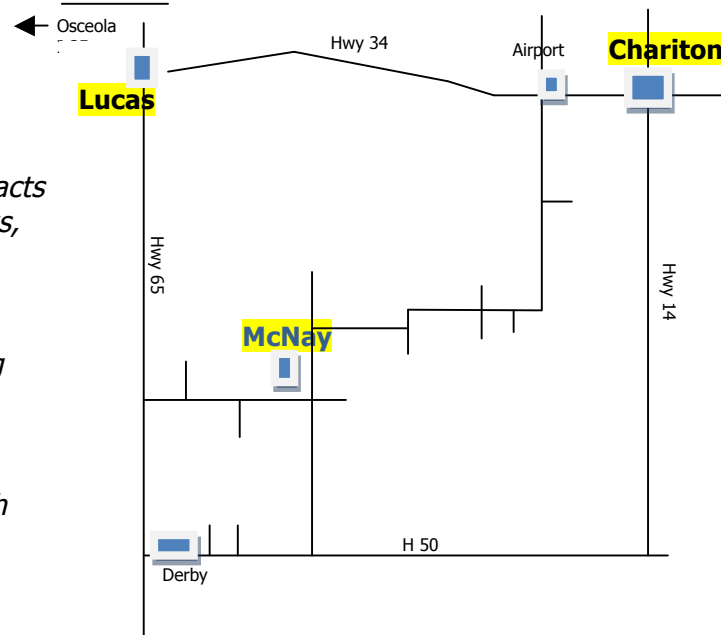
Directions to:
